Having been led by the grace of God through the life-giving power of the Holy Spirit to repent of sin and in faith turn to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and having given public testimony of this faith through baptism, we the members of Providence Baptist Church now joyfully and solemnly enter into this covenant:

We commit, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to affirm and follow the basic beliefs enumerated in this Constitution, to walk together in love, to remember one another in prayer, to help one another in times of need, to exercise gentleness and humility in our dealings with one another as we speak the truth in love, to be faithful in our responsibilities and commitments, to be just and honest in our dealings, and to honor ourselves and others for Christ's sake through sexual purity, personal integrity, and abstaining from things or practices which bring harm to our faith or the faith of another.

We commit to faithful participation in times of worship, prayer, study, and fellowship with other believers, to the building up of the Church by using our spiritual gifts in ministry, to contributing cheerfully and regularly for the ministry and expenses of the Church, the relief of the poor, and the spreading of the Gospel to the world.

We commit to practice personal and family worship, to train our children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord, and to seek the salvation of our family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, acquaintances, and all people of the world.

We agree to follow the Articles, Constitution, Bylaws, and policies and procedures of the Church, including those dealing with Church discipline, conflict resolution, and members' rights and responsibilities.
